REGISTRATION PROCESS FOR THE ENTRANCE EXAM

1. Digital Application

2. Interview (Either Physical or Digital)

Please note, that you can apply only for one program of study.

1. DIGITAL APPLICATION (2 FILES)

b) pdf-file with [APPLICATION](#) Form, motivational letter, CV with photo, and copy of lastschool certificate.

You may include drawings, paintings, prints, film/video, photography or sculpture. You may choose your personal artistic focus. Your portfolio of 20 to 30 original artworks can be supplemented with photographic documentation of objects which cannot be transported or which do not conform to the permissible portfolio format

PORTFOLIO DETAILS:

- The digitized portfolio should contain documentation of 10-20 artistic works (maximum 12MB).

- The works must each be accompanied by details of the work: Title, year of creation, dimensions (height x width x depth), materials; e.g. Portrait K. M., 2020, 100 x 60 cm, oil on canvas

- Sketchbooks: in addition, a maximum of 10 pages from sketchbooks may be documented.

If your portfolio includes time-based works:

- Time-based works (film, sound, documentation of performance works) may be included: up to 10 minutes from a selection of a maximum of 3 time-based works. Maximum total file size 300MB

- Label the file with the time-based works according to the following pattern (name, year of birth): mustermann-marie-2001_khs-mainz_2022.xyz

2. INTERVIEW

If you passed successful the first exam step you will be invited to an Interview (second step, 15 Min.)

Please bring to the interview the original signed application form and your portfolio or in case of a digital interview you will need to send your Portfolio to the Art Academy by post. With the invitation to the interview you will get further information.

APPLICATION AT JOHANNES GUTENBERG UNIVERSITY MAINZ (JGU)

The deadline for the application for winter semester 2022/23 at Johannes Gutenberg University of Mainz (JGU) is 15.07.2022.

For applicants who have neither acquired their university entrance qualification at a German-speaking institution nor a degree in a German-speaking course of study, proof of German language skills at level B2 is required, as well as the certificate of recognition of foreign certificates of previous education from the Johannes Gutenberg University Mainz.
