- CV in tabular form

- Photograph
- Copy of diploma or university entrance certificate (authentication not required)
- Written statement of grounds for choice of study subject
- Notification on registration form if you are submitting your work on electronic media (CD/DVD)
- Portfolio of 20 to 30 original artworks which may be freely chosen by the applicant

All artworks must be clearly marked with your full name and their year of origin. Please use a commercially available folder with a maximum format of DIN A0 (no wooden crates, boxes or similar, no rolls, no framed or stretched pictures).
